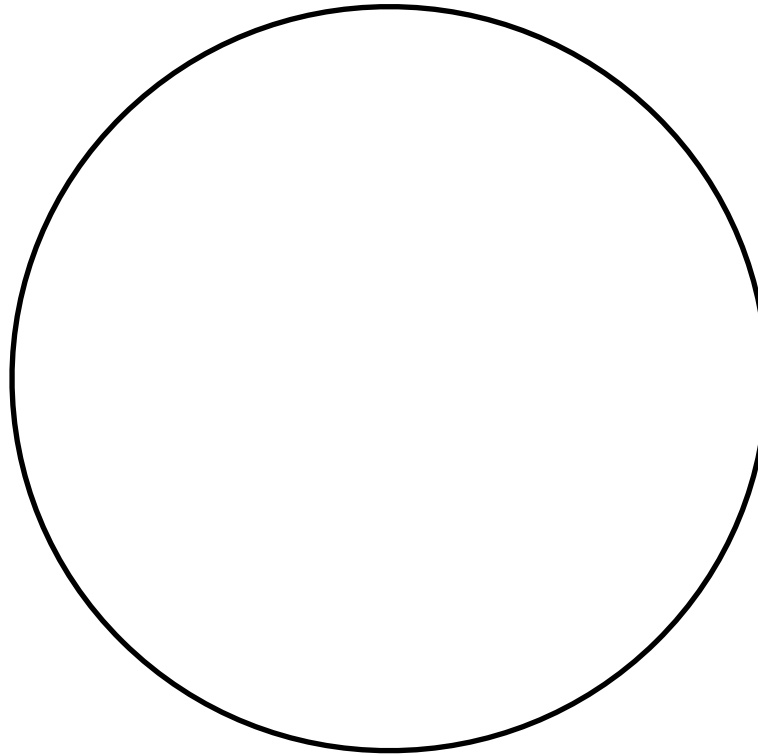


# Who is Responsible?

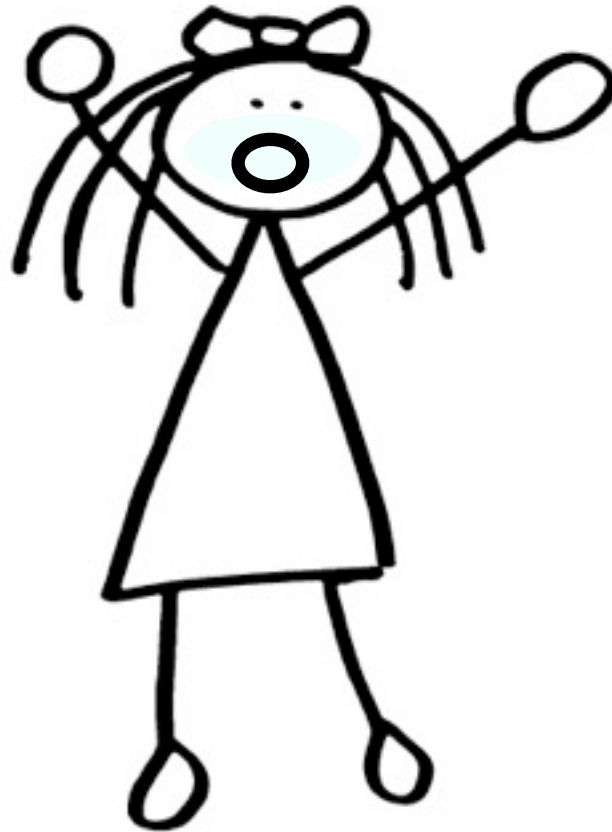


